May I present the annual report with your consent for your information and kind consideration. It was a great vision of the HDPY to donate the rural public a qualitative and competitive education. It has been being executed by the visionaries like late Sri. V.K Chandrabose and his elite colleagues viz. late Unnikrishnan Nair, Madhavan Moothandasseril etc for the last 25 years since 1994.

Every educational institution is estimated by its own merits on both academic and Co- Academic activities and their outputs. Last year we had 15 full A1s out of 52 students of the Board Exams where as this year we could score 3 full A1s.90 present and above is the criterion for A1 in the State where as in the CBSE, from last year onwards only 91 present and above is the minimum for A1. In certain subjects like Malayalam and English the cut off was 95 and 92 respectively. Actually 14 students have 91 present and above. They do deserve special mention for their outstanding performance in this year's Board Exams with 100% result both in 10th and 12th.They are Vyshakh Madhu T, Axza Mariya Sebastian, Niranjana. P.S, Akhil K.Arun, Adharsh K.V, Aleesha Unni, Ammu.M.P, Aneeta C.S, Dhananjai. S, Harison Viju, Jameela Hashim, Meeriya Reeghil, Neha Benny and Sandra Sunil in the Senior Secondary Section Jayasree .P, and Parvathy deserve special mention. All of you are heartily congratulated.

Besides the terminal exams, two-Midterm exams, 8 monthly test and two model exam are also conducted for the better performance of the students in the competitive CBSE exams. This year also we have a target of 100% result with more A1 in the public exams. All the portions are over and disciplined revisions are also going on. Counseling classes for both the parents and pupils have already been conducted. Further motivational demonstration training are also arranged for the 10th and 12th students. Special intensive coaching is also charted for a super success.

After the summer holidays the school was reopened on Monday 5th June 2018. Warm welcome was given to the new comers as well as the existing ones and especially to the kindergarten students.

On 19th June Reading day was observed with competitions in reading, review of books and quiz.

On 21st June International Yoga day was held with a massive Yoga demonstration and public meeting.

The founder's day in memory of Late Sri. V.K .Chandrabose was observed on 8th July in a befitting manner.

Prof. P.V Suraj Babu inaugurated the commemoration function with lighting the lamp by all the dignitaries including Secretary Sri .M.M.Thampi, President Sri.P.T.Santhosh Kumar etc.

As usual the hand writing competitions in Malayalam, Sanskrit, Hindi and English were held in July.

The Independence day was celebrated in a suitable way with march-past, flag hoisting, public meeting and cultural activities.

In the afternoon of 5th Independence Day the unexpected floods began to make its appearance with much ferocity and devastating nature. In the beginning our school became a relief centre and camp for more than 2000

refugees from the affected regions. But within a short time the school was also engulfed by 5th cruel waves Irreparable damage was done to the entire school.

At this context I congratulate all the concerned for their commendable contribution to rebuild the school. In the turmoil of the mid- Aug floods, this year's Onam Celebration was given up.
